AFTER YOUR ARRIVAL

- You have to make a few steps
 1. **Report your arrival** to the university office
 2. Arrange **a health insurance** during your stay at the office
 3. Get your **ISIC student card** - student discounts, entrance to the dormitory, borrowing from the library...
- Reminder: Your Buddy can help you with all these steps



CZECH LANGUAGE

- Our university offers basic Czech language courses for erasmus students that you will be able to enroll in
- **Basic phrases:**
 - “*Dobrý den*” - “Hello” (formal way)
 - “*Ahoj*” - “Hi” (informal way)
 - “*Na shledanou*” - “Goodbye”
 - “*Prosím*” - “Please”
 - “*Děkuji*” - “Thank you”
 - “*Jmenuji se...*” - “My name is...”
 - “*Jak se máš?*” - “How are you?”
 - “*Ano*” - “Yes”
 - “*Ne*” - “No”
 - “*(Jedno) Pivo prosím*” - “One beer please”



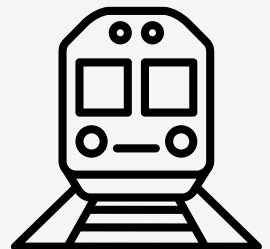
PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- Buses and trolleybuses run throughout the city
- You can use the application "**DÚKapka**" that works well for finding connections, which you download to your phone
- You have three options how to buy a ticket:
 1. One-time ticket purchased in the app mentioned above
 2. One-time ticket purchased from the driver
 3. Monthly travel pass with unlimited rides, purchased from a transport company



TRAVELLING

- For travelling outside the city and abroad, it is good to use the "**IDOS**" application
- You can find buses, trains or underground here
- **Prague** - capital of the Czech Republic
 - well connected by train
 - a direct connection takes about an hour
- **Dresden** - nearest German city
 - also good train connection
 - a direct train almost every two hours and it takes around an hour

This is a list of activities and things you should experience or try during your Erasmus stay!

- Arrive in Ústí nad Labem
- Try ice skating (winter season)
- Go to the Větruše viewpoint
